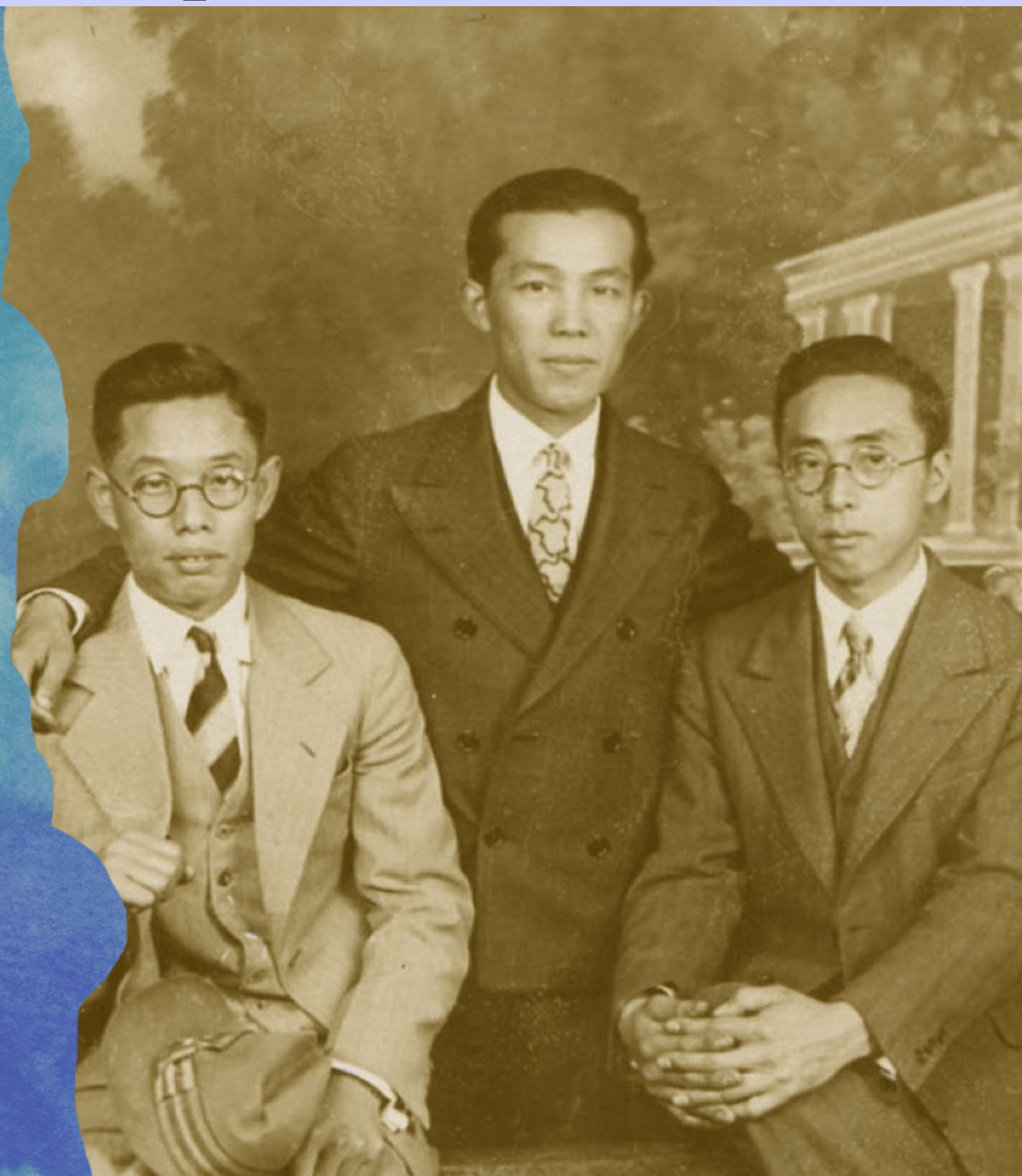

They will provide a brief overview of the exhibit and discuss their motivations for the project, the process of creating the exhibit, and the challenges and joys they encountered.
